



Tour of Istria

2nd-4th November, Croatia

Tour of Istria is classic car event on Croatian coastline. Weekend driving route covers more than 800 kilometres of public roads through diverse Mediterranean scenery – Roads vary from coastline twisting roads that stretches across three islands to 14% steep hill climb over 1400 m high mountain peak. Tour includes two ferry crossings and 1400 m long concrete bridge. Virtually empty winding roads, will guide you through thousands years old towns that stands in medieval form with monuments under UNESCO patronage. This year for the first time we included race track, three laps drive. On medieval maps Istria was known as “Terra Incognita”. Thousand years later it’s still virtually unknown. Those who have been there describe it as “Small Tuscany”. For two thousand years Istria was under strong Italian cultural influence so resemblance is not a surprise. Fifty years of communist regime made time stand still and Istria today strongly look like Italy in 50es and that is just the atmosphere for which your car was made. Add traditional Mediterranean cuisine, best truffles and olive oil in the world and pour a glass of wine. That is just what we had prepared for you.

Exactly hundred and ten years ago, in 1902, first touring event took place here. Horseless Carriages drove from Côte d'Azur Nice to Österreichisches Küstenland Opatija. We'll revive that spirit in Belle Époque Villa Polesini for Saturday dinner. Traditional Croatian malletier company Sljeme Autokoffer will provide present for participants, made exclusively in limited number to celebrate this anniversary.
